

Our Kitten Vaccine and Deworming Protocol

2-3 weeks old - 1st deworming

6 weeks old - First visit to Doctor

- Complete Physical Exam
- FVRCP vaccine (Feline Respiratory Vaccine)
- Fecal
- Deworming (In Clinic)
- First Flea and Heartworm Preventative (Kitten Pack)

10 weeks old - 2nd visit to Doctor

- Complete Physical Exam
- FVRCP vaccine (Feline Respiratory Vaccine)
- Feluk vaccine (Feline Leukemia Vaccine)
- Deworming (In Clinic)
- Flea and Heartworm Prevention

14 weeks old - 3rd visit to Doctor

- Complete Physical Exam
- FVRCP vaccine (Feline Respiratory Vaccine)
- Feluk vaccine (Feline Leukemia Vaccine)
- Rabies vaccine
- Deworming (In Clinic)
- Flea and Heartworm Preventative

6 months – Spay and Neuter your Kitten

We recommend that if you decide that you are going to want your kitten declawed that the best time to have it done is when they are being spayed or neutered so that they only have to be sedated one time. We also make pain management MANDATORY for all declaws which is an additional charge.

After the last set of kitten vaccines your kitten will need to come in annually for his/her annual vaccines and intestinal parasite test (fecal) with free in clinic deworming.

A dental check is always done when we do the annual vaccines. We recommend all your pets have annual dental cleaning.
